If you have been taking medication specifically to help your bladder relax or work better, stop taking it \*\*5 days\*\* before evaluation unless specifically instructed not to stop. Examples of Medication that should be stopped include:

Ditropan (oxybutynin)

Frequency of urination

- Probanthine (propantheline)
- Tofranil (imipramine)
- Uripas, Cystopaz, Dibenzyline, Minipress (prazosin)
- Detrol, Vesicare, Oxytrol, Santura, Toviaz, Enablex
- Flomax, Rapaflo, Uroxatral, Gelnique

DO NOT APPLY excessive body lotion, powder, or vaginal cream

**DO NOT STOP** antibiotics you are taking for bladder or kidney infections

Take antibiotics if you have Mitral Valve issues or if you take antibiotics before dental cleanings

DRINK – 24-32 ozs of water 60 minutes prior appointment
